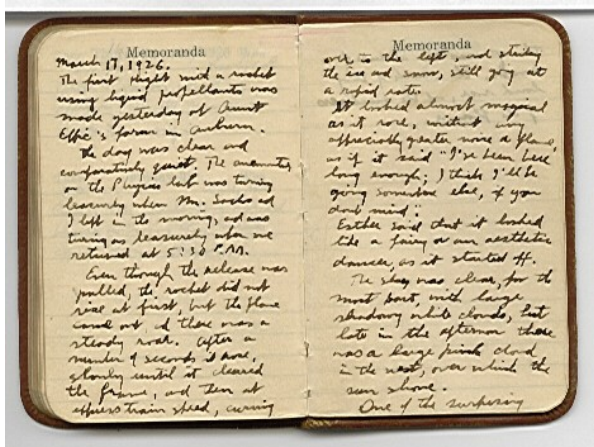


She and Tom took a roots trip to Poland in 2015. This affected Sylvia deeply.

Sylvia is a psychiatrist and psychoanalyst on the faculty of the Mt. Sinai School of Medicine in NYC and is past President of the NJ Psychoanalytic Society. Her memoir piece, "Googling for Ghosts: A Meditation on Writers' Block, Mourning and the Holocaust," appeared in the February 2012 issue of *Psychoanalytic Review*.
